Title:	Undergraduate Students Taking Graduate Courses Policy

RATIONALE

To reward high academic achievers, and to help students to graduate, RHU allows undergraduate students to register for graduate level courses in specific cases.

POLICY

An undergraduate student may be allowed to register for a maximum of 6 graduate credits under the following conditions:

- The student is in his last year of studies to complete the requirements for an undergraduate degree, has less than a full load of registered courses in a semester, and has a CGPA of at least 80.
- Substituting for a required undergraduate course not offered in the semester to graduate, provided that the student's CGPA is not less than 75.

In all cases, the student must obtain the college dean's approval.
